## Jobsupport CWO Tops TTW Open Employment Outcomes

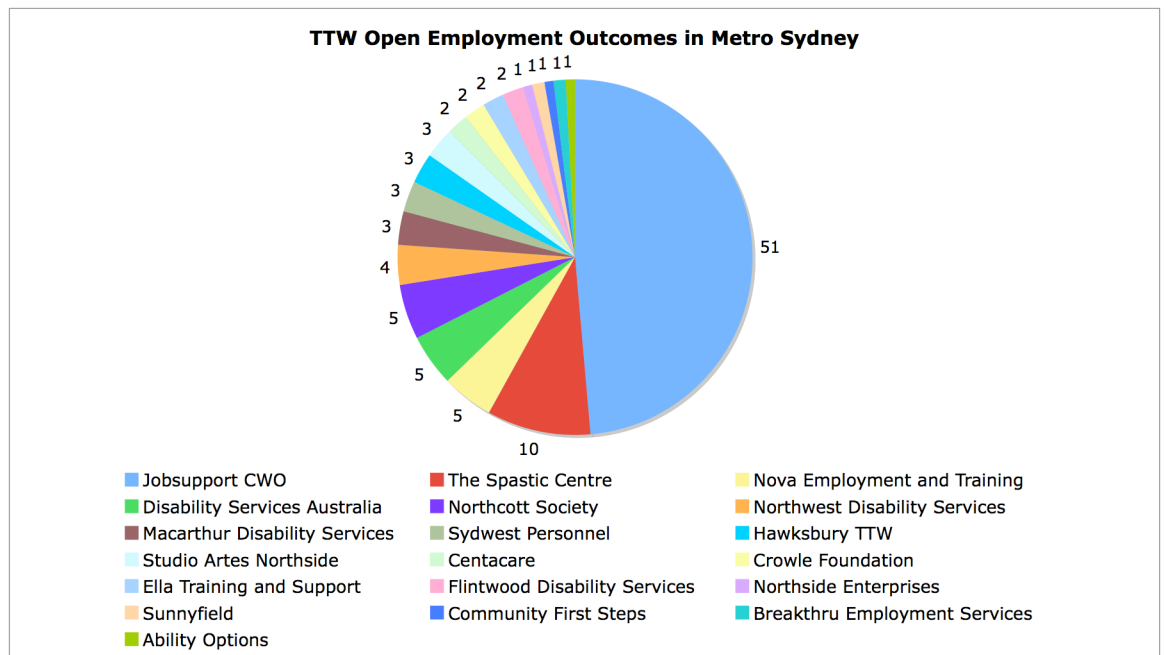
DADHC has published the results from the first two groups of Transition To Work (TTW) service users. This includes 2004 & 2005 school leavers and people who transferred from the ATLAS program in 2005.

Jobsupport Community Work Options (CWO) leads the open employment results with 51 out of 73 service users achieving paid employment in the regular workforce.

The release by DADHC of program results is very welcome. School leavers and their families now have a basis for informed choice when deciding which TTW service will best meet their transition goals.
