

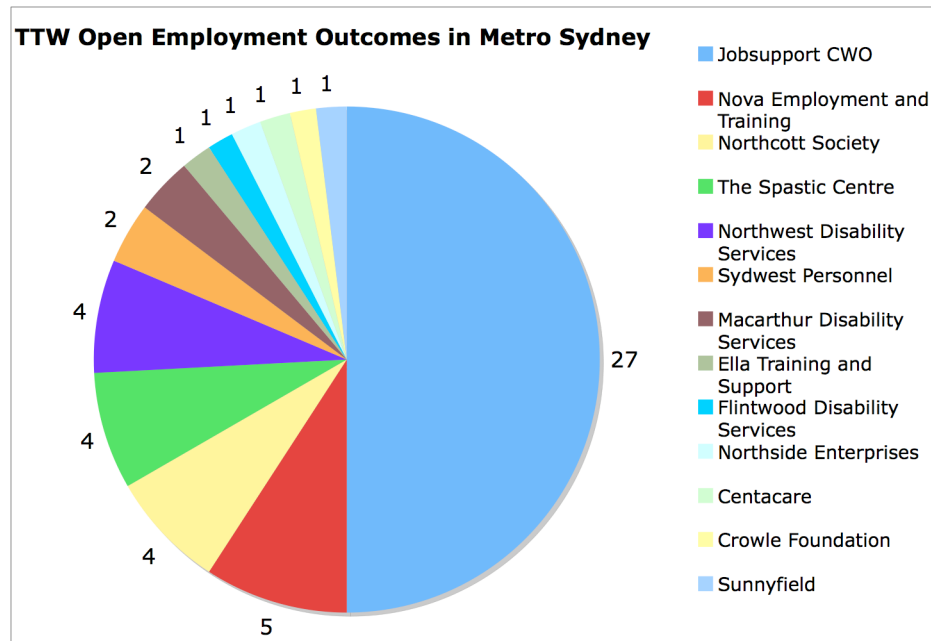
# C.W.O. Updates

## Jobsupport CWO Tops TTW Open Employment Outcomes

DADHC has published the results from the first group of Transition To Work (TTW) service users. This includes 2004 school leavers and people who transferred from the ATLAS program in 2005.

The results were collated from each of the TTW services in NSW, and list employment and other service user outcomes. Results are available in full at: <http://www.dadhc.nsw.gov.au/dadhc/People+with+a+disability/Post+School+Programs.htm>

Jobsupport Community Work Options (CWO) leads the open employment results with 27 out of 37 service users achieving paid employment in the regular workforce. **This is half of the total open employment outcomes for the Sydney Metropolitan regions.**



The release by DADHC of program results is very welcome. School leavers and their families should consider program results carefully when deciding which TTW service will best meet their transition goals.
