Jobsupport continues to top TTW Open Employment outcomes

ADHC has now published the results from the first five groups of Transition to Work (TTW) service users. This includes 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007 school leavers and people who transferred from the ATLAS program.

The ADHC results were collated from each of the TTW services in NSW and list employment and other service user outcomes. Additional information on the results is available at:

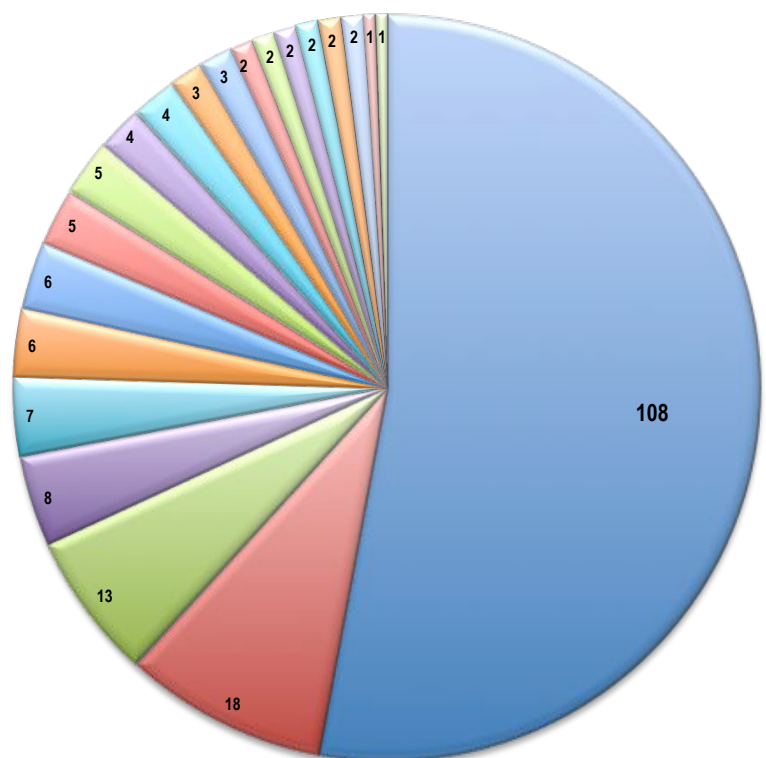

Jobsupport Transition leads the open employment results with 108 out of 179 service users achieving paid employment in the regular workforce.

The release of program results by ADHC is very welcome. These results provide school leavers and their families with a basis for informed choice when deciding which service will best meet their transition goals.
